

The University of Rovira i Virgili (URV) has been a partner on a large number of EC financed research projects. In the last five year 129 URV project have been founded with European funds for a total amount of more than 23.000.000€.

The CSSC is a "research center of the University Rovira Virgili," according to Article 127 of the Statutes of the URV, approved by the Govern Council in February 2015.

The research team involved in that project have much experience in researching and teaching in social, political, religious, economic and cultural conflicts research.

The lines of research in international and comparative perspective are:

- The role of the EU in armed conflict.
- The security of EU borders.
- Analysis of international terrorism and its consequences for the EU.
- Cooperation with third countries in safety.
- The EU contribution to the resolution of conflicts.
- The geopolitics of the EU in a polycentric world.
- Migration processes between the EU and third countries.
- The development of the right of European citizenship

Finally, the CSSC has a vast amount of experience in collaborating with civil society organizations in applied social transformation practices and the Local Action Coordinator, have valuable experience of managing EU projects.

For the development of these lines of research the CECOS has established a strategy cooperation with several universities and research institutes from different countries in Europe: Université de Luxembourg, CERIC Med: Mediterranean Centre for International Studies and Research (University of Rabat), Universidad Libanesa de Beirut - CEDS (Centre d'Edudes Diplomatiques et Strategiques) de París, University of México, chair of historical memory of the Universidad Complutense de Madrid.



## **CSSC**

**Overall objective**: to generate knowledge from a polyhedric perspective on globalization and the conflicting process in Spain and Europe, understood as "social conflict" the struggle of conflicting interests motivated by social facts, political, economic, gender, ethnic, religious and otherwise.
